NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 15th February, 2018

G.S.R. 170(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6C read with sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 (19 of 1952), the Central Government hereby makes the following scheme, further to amend the Employees' Deposit Linked Insurance Scheme, 1976, namely:-

- (1) This Scheme may be called the Employees' Deposit Linked Insurance (Amendment) Scheme, 2018.
 - (2) It shall come into force from the date of its publication in the official gazette.
- 2. In the Employees' Deposit Linked Insurance Scheme, 1976, in paragraph 22, -
 - (1) in sub-paragraph (3), for clause (i), the following shall be substituted, namely:-
 - "(i) the average monthly wages drawn (subject to a maximum of fifteen thousand rupees), during the twelve months preceding the month in which he died, multiplied by thirty times plus fifty per cent. of the average balance in the account of the deceased in the Fund or of a provident fund exempted under section 17 of the Act or under paragraph 27 or 27A of the Employees' Provident Funds Scheme, 1952, as the case may be, during the preceding twelve months or during the period of his membership, whichever is less subject to a ceiling of one lakh and fifty thousand rupees:

Provided that the assurance benefit shall not be less than two lakh and fifty thousand rupees:

Provided further that the assurance benefit shall not exceed six lakh rupees:

3. The provisions of the first proviso of clause (i) of sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 22 shall be in force for a period of two years from the date of publication of this Scheme in the Official Gazette."

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 25th January 2018 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 8 OF 2018.

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Labour Welfare Fund Act, 1972.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Labour Welfare Fund (Amendment) Act, 2018.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint.

Amendment of section 2.

 In section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Labour Welfare Fund Act, 1972, in clause (b), in sub-clause (i), in item (b), for the expression "draws wages exceeding three thousand and five hundred rupees per mensem", the expression "draws wages exceeding fifteen thousand rupees per mensem" shall be substituted. Tamil Nadu Act 36 of 1972.

ACT No. 9 OF 2018.

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Catering Establishments Act,1958.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-eighth year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Catering Establishments (Amendment) Act, 2018.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by

notification, appoint.

Short title and commence-ment. Amendment of section 23.

Tamil Nadu Act XIII of 1958

- 2. In section 23 of the Tamil Nadu Catering Establishments Act, 1958,-
- (1) in sub-section (1), for the expression "with fine which, for a first offence, shall not be, less than fifty rupees or more than one hundred and fifty rupees, for a second offence shall not be less than one hundred and fifty rupees or more than two hundred and fifty rupees and for a third or any subsequent offence shall not be less than two hundred and fifty rupees", the expression "with fine which, for a first offence, may extend to five thousand rupees and for a second or subsequent offence, with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees" shall be substituted;
 - (2) in sub-section (2),-
- (i) in clause (a), for the expression "with fine which may extend to one hundred rupees", the expression "with fine which may extend to five thousand rupees" shall be substituted;
- (ii) in clause (b), for the expression "with fine which may extend to twenty rupees", the expression "with fine which may extend to two hundred and fifty rupees" shall be substituted;
- (3) in sub-section (2-A), for the expression "with fine which may extend to five hundred rupees", the expression "with fine which may extend to one thousand rupees" shall be substituted;
- (4) in sub-section (3), for the expression "with fine which may extend to fifty rupees", the expression "with fine which may extend to five hundred rupees" shall be substituted.

VDA: In addition to the Basic wages, all Category of employees in the State shall be paid VDA @ 4 paise per point over and above 5780 points.

Note: Security Officer & Security Guard once in a year one pair Boots and 2 pair Socks or Yearly Rupees 850.00 should be paid to purchase a pair of boots and 2 pair of socks.

Night-time working guards every two years Mufflayer, Sweater or Rupees 300.00 should be given.

Every years, 2 pair Uniforms, Cap (Cap or Hat) and Belt or Rupees $1500.00\,\mathrm{should}$ be given.

Every month washing Allowance of Rs. 300.00 should be given.

For Night Guards, Battery and Torch should be given.

Facilities given already should be continued.
